

(ii) Pass an interim injunction, restraining the Respondents from vacating the persons with Disabilities holding licence to run STD/ ISD/ PCO booths after 27.04.2007 in the Railway Stations pending WP. No. 14480 of 2007 respectively.

Order: This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/S. D. Geetha, Advocate for the petitioners in both the petitions the court made the following order:-

Issues notice to the respondents returnable by 18/6/2007. Notice to indicate that the writ petition shall be disposed of at the admission stage. The notice of the first respondent to be served on Mr. P. Wilson, learned Asst. Solicitor General of India. The respondents are directed not to demolish the booths or to interfere with the possession of the allottees of the booths, including the petitioner, in any manner until further orders.
